ACTIVITY I found an interesting potato at the pantry which gave me this idea. Here's a photo.
What I would like you to do is get maybe two potatoes and slice them (be careful! Mum or Dad can help here) into say two centimetre slices.
You need three slices (each)
Then on a cutting board cut out

- A cross- a symbol of faith
- An anchor- symbol of hope and
- A heart- symbol of love.

There! Faith, Hope and Love.
