What is a Community Pantry?

We provide basic grocery items and produce at low cost. Some items are free.

We are a not-for-profit project designed to create a welcoming community centre:- a place to belong, contribute and find support. We will respect your privacy.

Where is the Pantry?

The pantry is a joint effort by church and community and is located at the Uniting Church Hall, 20 Chandos Street, Eden.

When are we open?

Thursdays from 10am to 1pm.
And each third Saturday of the month from 10am – 12pm, during the regular Eden Community Market.

Who can come?

The Pantry is for everyone. You don't have to become a member or show any ID.
We are keen to assist community members who are struggling to meet their budget demands. There are many reasons why any of us can find ourselves in this situation!

People struggle because of natural disasters, economic uncertainty or health issues. Please let our volunteers know as we are able to provide extra supports. You won't need to fill in forms to receive help. Even if you feel isolated or generally unhappy we can provide a listening ear or helpful information.

Who runs the Pantry?

The Pantry is run by volunteers who care and want to serve their community. All volunteers are given opportunities for training so we can continue to provide a good service. New volunteers are always welcome.
